### Former Lifeguard Saves Toddler from Drowning

CitiSlickers is honored to have a genuine life-saving hero in our family. Adri Kruger, the daughter of CitiSlickers veteran **Lyn Kruger**, prevented heartbreaking sorrow when she saved a 5-year-old boy from drowning this past June. The unconscious child had no heartbeat when bystanders rescued him from Barton Creek, near Austin, where he had been swept underwater.

Adri, a University of Oklahoma student and former lifeguard, assisted the rescue effort by performing CPR to successfully resuscitate the boy.

"I'm very proud of Adri," said mom Lyn. "Her quick thinking prevented a tragedy."

CitiSlickers has many real-life heroes on our team but today we salute Adri Kruger whose selflessness and swift actions did indeed avert a tragedy for one Texas family.
